The STEM Community Platform is an online clearinghouse of information about program offerings, career information, and resources. Our community platform offers a wide variety of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics, cataloged in one convenient location. The Omaha STEM Ecosystem (OSE) and the AIM Institute have come together to build this resource for the community, and we invite any organization interested in building the Greater Omaha's STEM community to participate, including STEM service providers, businesses, educators, Greater Omaha Chamber of Commerce members and community organizations.

Why is this important?

A healthy, vibrant community depends on a skilled and growing workforce. To achieve this end, a strong infrastructure and capacity to connect and collaborate is essential. Early studies indicated the Greater Omaha area had numerous resources around STEM education and engagement but were operating in a silo that often did not align with business and industry needs. The STEM Community Platform will:

- Connect programs and resources to facilitate efficient and effective career pathways to close the talent gap
- Create a community culture as THE primary resource for sharing and promoting STEM programs and resources
- Communication tool for parents, students, educators, business, non-profits, and industry partners
- Create a database to conduct collective impact study on factors that lead to STEM careers
- Create a community on website with over 36,000 reach and a connect rate to over 570,000 families
